



TEXAS TIRE & AUTOMOTIVE ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Requirements/Qualifications

- Any immediate family member of a current TTAA member OR current TTAA member's employee.
- Has applied or been accepted to accredited 2 or 4 year school.
- Has maintained a 3.0 or better Grade Point Average on a 4.0 scale.
- Submit application to TTAA office no later than **March the 1st of Each Year**.
- Applications received after that date will be considered for the next year.
- May be used for Tuition for a United States based college/ university/ technical school.
- May not be used for advanced degrees (such as Masters, PhD).
- Will be made only to accredited higher-education institutions and vocational/ trade schools
- United States Citizenship

Completed Application packets to include

- High School/College Transcript
- TTAA Application Form
- Letters of Recommendation. May include a TTAA Member Sponsor Recommendation.
- Stated Need (optional)

Funding

Total annual scholarship dollars will be determined by the TTAA Scholarship Committee based on funds available. Total dollars allocated for each individual scholarship will also be based on current scholarship funds available. Individual scholarships will never be less than \$500.

Policies

Repeat applicants are welcome but first consideration must be given to new applicants. All applications received by deadline will be evaluated by the Scholarship Committee to determine eligibility. Selections will be forwarded to the TTAA Board of Directors for final approval.

Presentation

To be made at the TTAA Annual Convention. All recipients will be invited to accept in person. Recipient does not have to be present at the convention in order to receive scholarship.

The TTAA Scholarships are for students pursuing a degree at an accredited:
Four-year College or University, Two-year College (Community or Junior College), Vocational/ Technical/ Trade School
